We provide training to volunteers and provide technical assistant to support the local residents physically and webinar. Initially, started **free medical camps** through out Sindh, particularly in remote area of Sindh and Punjab.Later on after seeing interest of local public and support of volunteers this organization has established 5 medical centre and working on to start online clinic in rural areas to provide quality care health services.

Similarly in education sector, organized number of career counseling programs in different cities through experts. Provided free of cost classes for potential candidates of CSS/PMS candidates and established CSS/PMS preparatory School, Latifabad.

During flood and Rain emergency, organized medical camps with qualified doctors along with paramedical staff, medicine and basic lab test coverage through out Sindh. After seeing prolong period of evacuation of flooded water, people were stuck in area. Therefore, an area of District Nousherferoz was selected. Where warm cloths, Jackets, sweaters, blankets, sleepers were distributed. Rs 50,000 Cash amount was distributed number families in District Kamber.

Climate change is a big problem of Pakistan.Responsibility lies on every citizen of Pakistan to promote greenery and avoid waste and reduce the practices which lead to increase the pollution.twice in year our volunteers conduct the programs for awareness to stop pollution and increase plantation through tree plantation.

We hope that this organization will its play role to change the society through dedicated work.

<Latifabad#7

Centre is located in centre of city Latifabad. Where experienced consultants are offering their services. In this Centre New Qadeer Pathology Lab , X-Ray and Ultra Sound facilities already available. Ophthalmology unit has been installed. Where periodically free of cost operations are being carried out.

< Hosri, Hyderbad

Hosri is a village nearby Hyderabad city. Where Health care services are being provided to resident of village. Where proper doctor and medicine are available through this organization. Here every month free medical camps are also being carried out to provide maximum coverage.

<Bag-e-Korangi

After conducting survey it was decided by the organization to open welfare clinic in Bag-e-Korangi, Karachi. Where Lab, Pharmacy and consultants are offering their services in nominal fees. Local community is very much supportive and offering their services related to social mobilization for conducting Medical Camps and Health awareness sessions.



Medical centre was established where mostly labour workers of factories are living. Resident of this area is low paid and living below the poverty line. Here hepatitis B and C, mouth ulcer, and water borne decease are being reported. This organization is working with local community to provide the quality care and nominal fees just to avoid functional patients.

<Altaf Nagar, Orangi

Another suburb area of Karachi was selected by the organization. Here online consultation is being provided through internet. Para-medical staff provides assistance and basic medicine are being provided after consultation of Doctor. Some doctors are providing online consultancy. Dr. Bilal Nauro-Physician, Dr. Zafar Iqbal Diabetologist. Dr. Khatija.









Village Sarhari,

26th September 2022, Foundation carried out a free medical camp for the flood and rain effectees at village Sahri near Nawabshah. Hundreds of people were examined and provided with free of cost medicines. Dr. Hamid Shakoor Pediatrician, Dr. Amber Hamid Gynecologist, Dr. Akram General Physician, Dr. Irum Akram Gynecologist and Dr. Dua performed their duties during camp. Camp was facilitated by the local team Muhammad Alam Shams, Abdul Gaffar, Rehan Akhter, Amjad Gani, Aijaz Akram, Muhammad Ilyas. Mr. Ghaffar, Nasir and Awais Khanzada. Prime objective of the camp was to facilitate and minimize the sufferings of flood effected. Recent flood poured and undaunted the different area's in Sindh and devastated infrastructure of the area.



On 23-10-22 one day medical camp was organized by volunteers of foundation in District Nousheroferoz. Mass publicity was ensured through local radio, announcement in mosque and banners were placed in prominent places of rain and flood affected areas. Dr. Bilal and Aqsa Sehto ensured free medicine, consultancy and lab test free of costs. Total 1510 patients were treated.





Altaf Nagar, Orangi

On 18th January 2022 a one-day free diabetes camp was organized by the Foundation in Altaf Nagar, Orangi Town Karachi. On this occasion, Dr. Zafar Iqbal Abbasi, a diabetes specialist, provided his services. While free medicines were also provided to the patients. Dr. Zafar Iqbal Abbasi gave health session to patients. He said that the disease of diabetes is spreading rapidly in Pakistan. About 23% of the country's population is suffering from this disease. He said that we have left the habits of daily exercise and adopted eating un-healthy items. He said that there is an urgent need to bring changes in our daily routines. On this occasion, patients and participants appreciated the tireless service of HEW Foundation and hoped that this work will be continued.



On 18-9-2022 a medical camp was arranged in Bucheri is village near District Banazirabad. During general medical camp free medicians, consultancy, lab test were arranged for rain affected people of surrounding. Male OPD 245, Female 300, Paeds 315, Lab test 65. Nasir Ahmed and his team made this event successful. Awais Ahmed, Gaffar Ahmed, Dr Akram Khan, Ilyas Ahmed. Dr Bilal Ahmed.





Eye Surgeries

Hew Foundation conducted free medical camps in remote area of Hyderabad Division. Hosri, Kotri, Tando Hyder. Where patients were screened and selected for free of cost surgeries. Surgeries were conducted by renowned surgeons in Hew Medical Centre, Latifabad, Hyderabad.

On request of citizen of Tharoshah Town of District Nousherferoz two days eye surgical camp was organized by the volunteers of foundation. Where free optical glasses, phaco surgeries, free medicine and lab test were conducted. In two days 828 OPD, 72 surgeries were operated by consultants. In 2022 total 107 free of cost surgeries were recorded. They were provided transportation facilities by the organization. Sindh Institute of Ophthalmology & Visual Science, Sindh (SIOVS) and this organization's medical Team including Dr Shahid Jamal, Dr Nusrat Shah, Dr Naseem Alvi ophthalmologist and volunteers of foundation made these event successful.



International Day

On 14th November World Diabetes day observed in bag-e- Korangi and led by renown diabetologist Dr. Zafar Iqbal Abbasi from Baqai University, Karachi. Where, he briefed before electronic media and print media personals regarding increasing of numbers of cases day by day. He pointed out that our life style and eating habits need to be changed and simplified.



Sira-e-Mughal

Sira-e-Mughal is a village near District Phool Nagar, Lahore Division.Local residents contacted with management and requested to start social work in their UC. Team has been built up. Survey was conducted regarding social and economic issue of the residents. Different events are being organized with support of volunteers. In first phase consultative meeting was carried out through webinar.



It was requested by the residents that a medical camp should be organized wherein different doctors from different speciality should be invited for participation.

Diabetes clinic will be established in different cities and town of Pakistan to provide the quality health care service.


Organization intends to promote online clinic through Patients management system.
